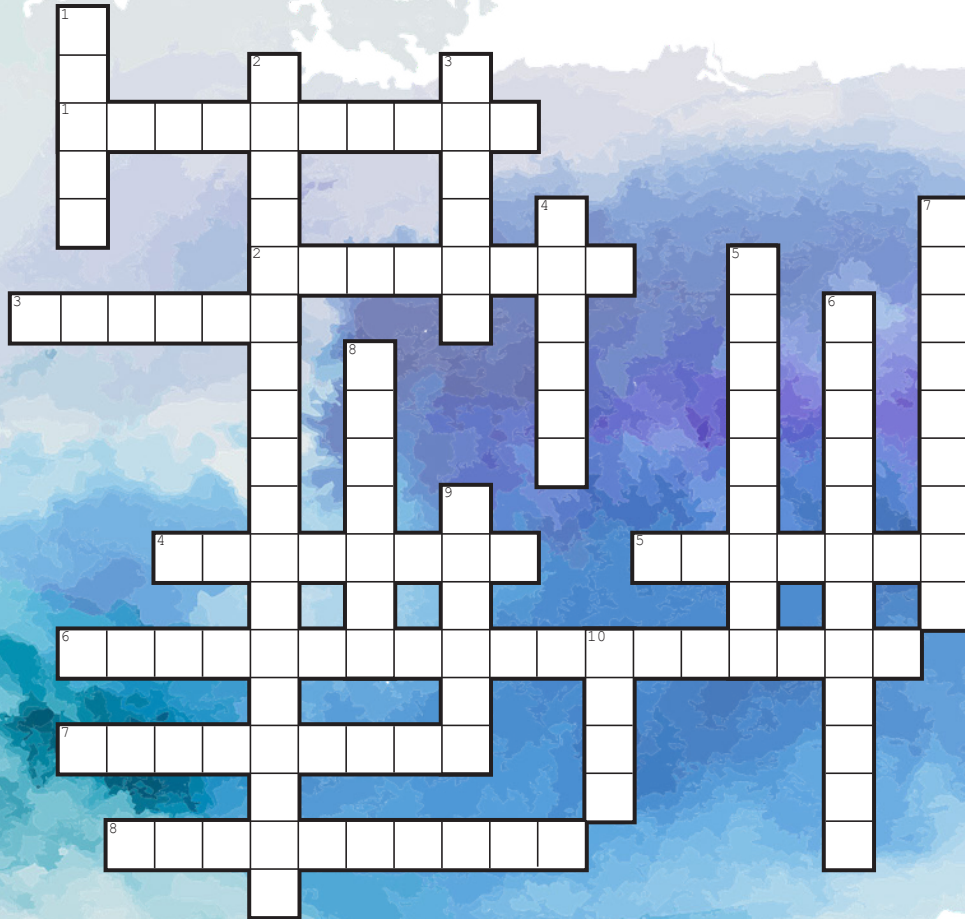


CROSSWORD PUZZLE

1. Lives primarily on Macquarie Island
2. The ___ are larger and have longer crest feathers than the Southern species (write without space)
3. Has a bright orange beak and white eye patches
4. Is named after the wife of Dumont d'Urville, the French Antarctic Explorer
5. Has a narrow black band going from the chin to the cheek
6. ___-___ are named for their crest of yellow plumes that are erect, or bristle up over their eyes (write without dashes)
7. The only crested penguin with white stripes on their cheeks
8. The largest of the penguin species
9. Has bare pink skin at the base of its large red-brown bill
10. The closest relative to the largest penguin species

1. The largest penguin to breed on the mainland of New Zealand is the ___-___ penguin. (write without dashes)
2. This South American penguin's habitat is mostly along coastal Peru
3. The smallest species of penguin
4. Its scientific name derived from Greek means "good diver with a golden crest"
5. Has a distinctive pink patch above the eyes
6. Similar to its Northern counterpart, this penguin is smaller and has shorter spiky crests (write without space)
7. The only penguin found north of the equator
8. This penguin was named after a Portuguese explorer
